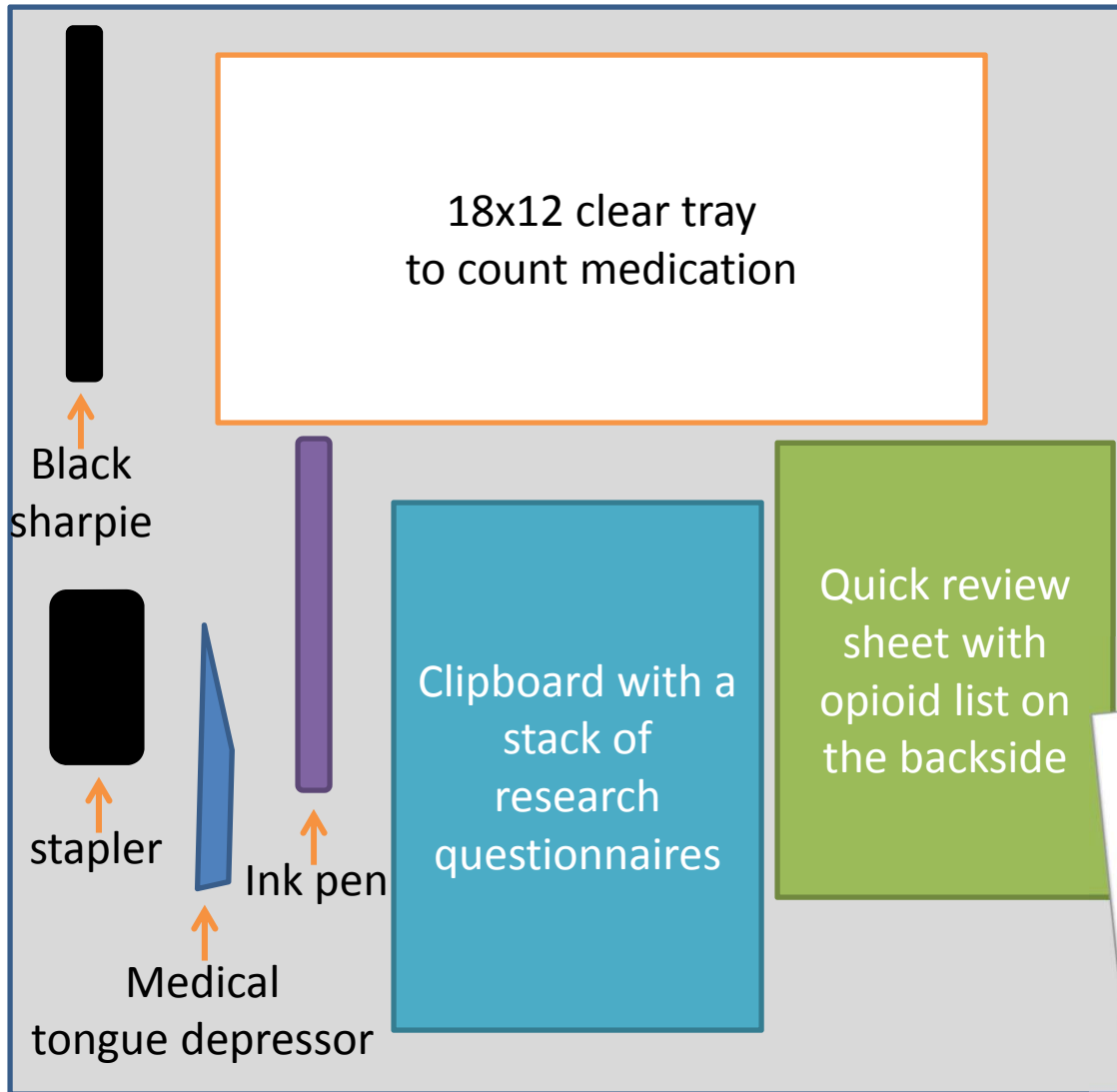

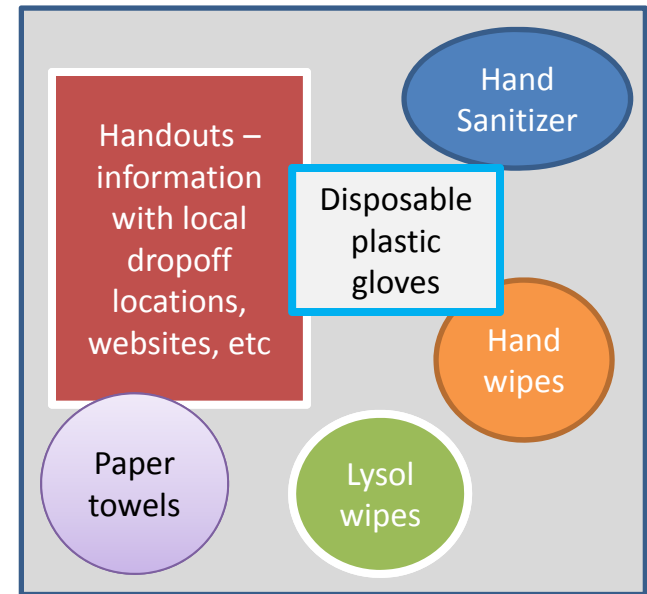

Quick Review- Drop-off pills and capsules

- ✓ Police officer at drug disposal box at all times
- ✓ Hospital staff asks a few optional questions
- ✓ Pills/capsules can only be touched by person who brings them. They pour the pills directly inside the box
- ✓ The person can either keep the empty pill bottle or throw away. Sharpies available to cross off information

- ✓ Research questionnaire:
 - Information gathered only for medications on list
 - Estimated count only, not exact
 - 5 questions total, please try and complete each line

What's accepted?

- ✓ Pills/capsules- any and all
- ✓ Patches
- ✓ Inhalers after 2014
- ✓ Expired or unwanted prescriptions/controlled substances
- ✓ Pet medications in pill/capsule form

What's not accepted?

- No liquids
- No EpiPens
- No creams and gels
- No needles, syringes, lancets
- No thermometers
- No IV bags
- No sprays
- No vials
- No powders
