In Michigan,
you can get naloxone through

State Registered Pharmacies

- Pharmacist generates a prescription using the **State Naloxone Standing Order**
- No prescription needed
- Ask the pharmacist for naloxone
- Pay the co-pay pending on your insurance
- Medicaid: \$0-\$3 copay; other insurances co-pay range of up to \$149
