IMPACT REPORT 2023

OPEN is working to reduce opioid-related deaths by expanding access to barrier-free naloxone, a life-saving medication that reverses the effects of an opioid overdose. We support hospital-based programs, community distribution, and tailored naloxone administration training, education and resources.


EVIDENCE

 Providing naloxone to at-risk patients does **NOT** increase opioid use or overdose

In patients treated for non-fatal opioid overdose **20%** died within **ONE month** AND **NEARLY 5%** died within **TWO days**

ONLY 1.1% of patients who had an opioid-related ED visit filled a naloxone prescription
