to at-risk patients does **NOT** increase opioid use or overdose

In patients treated for non-fatal opioid overdose 20% died within ONE month AND NEARLY 5% died within TWO days

ONLY 1.1% of patients who had an opioid-related ED visit filled a naloxone prescription
