Inspired by true stories of addiction and recovery, Painless: The Opioid Musical was developed to engage and educate high school students about opioid use disorder.

Painless is a collaboration between OPEN, the University of Michigan School of Music, Theatre, and Dance, School of Nursing, and School of Public Health.

EVIDENCE

Nearly **50%** of teens say prescription medication is **easy to get** from their parents' medicine cabinet



1 in 4 teens report taking a prescription drug that was not prescribed to them at least once in their lives
