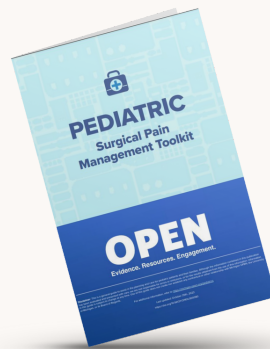

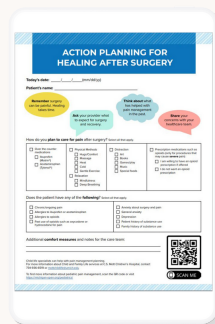
significantly more opioids were prescribed to children in the overweight and obese BMI categories compared to those in the healthy weight category
